The City will relocate City fiber optic infrastructure in conflict with building plans, as determined by the Plans Examiner.</p> <p>However, contractors will be responsible for the repair costs associated with any damage to fiber optic infrastructure caused by the contractors or their assigned subcontractors. A fee will be added to the permit for any repair required.</p> <p>Be careful to avoid fiber optic boxes and markers in the right of way when excavating a site.
