## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDE FOR 2021 APPLICANTS



This guide will help Southwest Florida Community Foundation scholarship applicants confidently submit their application.

#### **Applicant Registration:**

You will be able to log in and out of your scholarship application.

- 1) Your email address will be your user ID.
- Make sure your email address is professional and that you have access to the email account you choose as your user ID.
- Check your email frequently and stay updated on your scholarship application's progression, as well as other updates.
- Write down your user ID and password, so you can reference it if you forget your login information.

#### **Prequalifying Questions:**

Your answers, to these questions, will determine what scholarships you are eligible for.

- 1) Read each question thoroughly.
- 2) Answer each question honestly.
- After submitting your prequalifying question answers, you will be able to view the available scholarship(s) that you are eligible for.
- After receiving your eligible scholarship list, click the box next to the scholarship (s) you would like to apply for.
- You will not be able to apply for scholarships outside of this list, so be sure you are answering the prequalifying questions with accuracy and honesty.

#### **Required Documents:**

All of the required documents must be uploaded, in order to have the ability to submit your application.

- Transcript
   – you must highlight your cumulative unweighted (state) GPA.
- Reference Letter
   – at least one is required.
- FAFSA– your FAFSA's Student Aid Report (SAR) is required for <u>all</u> scholarships. Your SAR must include your EFC score. If this is an issue, please contact us.
- Some scholarships may require additional uploads.

#### Additional Tips:

We want you to be confident in the application you submit.

- Consider your answers to be your way of introducing yourself to the reviewers.
- Take your time! You have the ability to logout and login as you please. Give yourself enough time to complete the application without rushing.
- Be aware that you will not be able to submit your application until you have completed all of your application sections and have uploaded all of the required documents.
- Preview your application PDF, before submitting, to make sure everything uploaded properly.

## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDE FOR 2021 APPLICANTS



This guide will help Southwest Florida Community Foundation scholarship applicants confidently submit their application.

### Writing Worksheet

#### Write Effectively

Expand on a topic by using specific, concrete examples to support what you are writing about. Don't just simply make a list of accomplishments, activities, work or awards, because that will lessen the impact of your words.

#### Proofread & Edit

Make sure you are communicating clearly. Reread your work. Take breaks. Read your responses out loud and listen to your word choices. Be concise. You may not have enough space to tell us everything, so make your words count.

Ask for Help

#### Start Early

You do not have a lot of time to complete your application, so it's important to start early. Give yourself time to make revisions. Give yourself time to brainstorm. The more time you give yourself, then the more time you have to perfect your work. Relax. Seek guidance from your teachers, coaches, bosses, counselors, parents, siblings and friends. Type all of your responses into a separate document and have someone ur ancheck for grammar, spelling our reand syntax errors.

Relax. Don't over think your answers. Don't oversaturate your responses.

Breathe!

Your answers to these questions will help you figure out the most important parts of you to include in your application.

#### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### The deadline to apply is Monday, January 11, 2021 by 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time

#### Things to consider before completing a Scholarship Application:

- Complete the FAFSA, which will provide you with the SAR report that is required.
- Obtain Letter(s) of Recommendation.
- Obtain your most recent transcript and highlight your cumulative unweighted (state) GPA.

#### Q. What documents do I need to upload in addition to filling out the application?

A: 1. FAFSA: Student Aid Report (SAR) from the completion of your FAFSA that indicates your Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) score. This is a requirement for all scholarships.

2. Transcript: Most recent transcript with your cumulative unweighted/state GPA highlighted.

3. Letter of Recommendation: At least one letter of recommendation is required. Your letter of recommendation should be written by someone outside of your family.

#### Q. I don't have access to a scanner or fax machine. What do I do?

**A.** All required documents must be uploaded into your online application. If you don't have access to a scanner or fax machine, please take a picture of your document and upload it into your application. Be sure to check and make sure your photo is legible. If you do not have access to a phone, please email me at

scholarships@floridacommunity.com. However, do not send us copies of the required attachments, as <u>everything must be submitted online, and hard copies will not be</u> <u>accepted</u>.

#### Q. Do my letters of recommendation have to be signed and on letterhead?

**A.** No, they don't have to, but be sure your reference's contact information is included on the letter.

#### Q. What financial documentation is required?

A. You must include a copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which is an application students and their families must complete in order to be considered for federal financial aid. Many states and schools also use the FAFSA as part of their application process for non-federal aid. The Student Aid Report (SAR) is the report received that summarizes the student's financial need and provides the official Expected Family Contribution (EFC) number. Be sure and talk to your parents about the documentation required so that there is plenty of time to gather the information needed prior to the deadline, as we cannot review incomplete applications. This is a requirement for all scholarship applications.

#### Q. How will I be notified if I am awarded a scholarship?

**A.** If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be notified by email or by mail in late April.
