The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chair Lomonaco

## APPROVAL OF MINUTES June 6, 2017 Regular Meeting

Board Member Pippenger moved, seconded by Board Member Keim to approve minutes of the June 6, 2017 meeting as presented. Voice poll: All "ayes." 4-0 Motion carried.

## ORDER OF UNFINISHED BUSINESS Updated Cost Values for the SE 47<sup>th</sup> Terrace Streetscape Project

Executive Director Szerlag became aware of the increase of the estimated cost of this project. Staff had developed an estimated cost for \$8.5 million for the streetscape project from Coronado to Del Prado Boulevard. A Construction Manager at Risk and design engineer were hired, we are at the 30% cost estimates and unfortunately the costs have increased. He wanted to let the Advisory Board, CRA Board, and Council know this. It was still a great project and he was requesting the Advisory Board recommend to continue with the project. The completion date would be Fall of 2018. The City would pay the \$5.2 million dollars for the undergrounding infrastructure: water, sewer, and storm water. The CRA would pay for balance, approximately \$10.8 million dollars. Because the CRA did not have the funding to do all that in one or two years, he proposed a bank loan of 10 years and that will still provide funding availability of for the capital projects.

Public Works Director Clinghan reviewed the July 28 memo pertaining to the SE 47<sup>th</sup> Terrace Streetscape Improvement Project.

<u>Chair Lomonaco</u> understood the lighting cost came as a shock with that much of an increase. She asked if the Advisory Board would be able to see what other options there were.

Executive Director Szerlag requested reigning in the cost of the lighting.

Discussion held.

Executive Director Szerlag recommended a workshop meeting be held on Tuesday, August 29 to discuss the lighting options.

Discussion held.

Board Member St. Peter moved, seconded by Board Member Pippenger to recommend approval to move forward with the project and to proceed with a tenyear bank loan for the Agency's portion of the additional costs, and to reexamine the project when design is at the 60% or 90% phase.

Board members polled as follows: Keim, Lomonaco, Pippenger, and St. Peter voted "Aye." 4-0 Motion carried.

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## ORDER OF NEW BUSINESS Ordinance 36-17/Extending SC Parking Requirement Effective Date

Planning Team Manager Pederson stated the parking requirements for the CRA would expire on August 20, 2017, the date needed to be extended to August 17, 2025.

Board Member Pippenger moved, seconded by Board Member St. Peter to recommend the approval of Ordinance 36-17 extending the effective date of certain minimum parking requirements in the South Cape Downtown District as presented.

Board members polled as follows: Keim, Lomonaco, Pippenger, and St. Peter voted "Aye." 4-0 Motion carried.
