An ordinance amending the Future Land Use Map from Single Family Residential (SF) to Multi-Family Residential (MF) land use designation for property located at 1049 Embers Parkway and 320 Nelson Road. (Applicant: City of Cape Coral)

He stated This will serve as a gateway to the Seven Islands. He said they accept staff's presentation.

- There is no impact on schools or parks.
- The lots are surrounded by single family homes.
- The residents will be buffered with landscape, and will have lighting.
- There are 3 separate ownerships this is a unified investment.
- Rezone from single family to commercial

Mr. Stewart continued to explain the 7 Island landscape and how they were similar. He said the staff noted the property is surrounded by single family lots. Access will be on Embers Parkway. He stated there are 3 separate ownerships that are unified.

John Smart stated he was representing the Northwest Neighborhood Association, and they are in support.

<u>Commissioner Schneider</u> asked Mr. Boyko if he had a response from the two home owners that are near to this location?

Principal Planner Boyko agreed there could be some increased traffic coming off the side road. Once there is a physical development and the zoning has changed the City will revisit this and determine how to minimize the traffic flow.
